## Bowling Green Arts Council Meeting Minutes Tuesday, May 5, 2015

- I. Approval of April minutes- Karen moved; Jacqui seconded. Approved.
- II. Action Items Preparing for Art in the Park
  - Advertising- <u>Beth</u> will send out a press release to local newspapers; she would like information—especially from Marilyn, Karen, and Deb regarding music and theatrical performances. <u>Beth has requested this information</u>, if possible, by Monday, May 11<sup>th</sup>.

Brenda and John will interview with Clint (88.1) the Wednesday before the event. Any other BGAC members who wish to participate in the interview should contact John or Brenda.

<u>Jacqui</u> has agreed to create posters/flyers for the event. Jacqui has also offered to update the current BGAC flyer and have copies ready to distribute at the event.

<u>Brenda</u> has agreed to put information about the event on the BGAC website and on BGAC's facebook page.

- Refreshments <u>Nancy</u> will bring 12 dozen (!) cookies. <u>Alice/John</u> will bring table clothes, plastic cups, napkins, lemonade, and sweetened iced tea; Deb will bring a case of water.
- Music/Theatre The Horizon Youth Theatre will perform (likely in the Children's Garden) on June 5th; The Black Swamp Players will explore locations at Simpson and perform at the same time as HYT and musical acts. Marilyn is coordinating music with Timmy C.; a variety of musical acts/artists will perform throughout the park from 5-7 pm.
- Artists Art in the Park is a Pleine-air event that will involve artists painting at easels.

Painters who participate must: 1) sign in (in front of the Garage at Simpson, where there will be a sign-in table) on the day of the event between 4:00 and 4:30. (June 5<sup>th</sup> or in case of rain June 12<sup>th</sup>). 2) stay until 7:00; and 3) bring their own supplies (easels, paints, brushes, etc.)

Artists can not sell their work on Park premises, but can bring business cards with contact information.

\*\*\*\*BGAC members present at the meeting who will be assisting at Art in the Park agreed to arrive at 4:00 and stay until 7:15.

Brenda will bring name tags for all BGAC members on the day of the event so that they are identifiable to assist participants and guests.

## III. Committee Reports

Artists for Animals – The show and reception were a success; many attended. Cards from the winners (\$10 each) will be available soon; Jacqui agreed to have her students prepare card packets on Wednesday. Jacqui is working on getting the exhibition taken down, but is having difficulty because H&R Block has limited hours at this time.

Internet and Web Committee – This group (Brenda, Jacqui, Kelsey, Deb) will be examining various commercial web-hosting sites (e.g. Square Space) to assess the best choice, based upon cost, ease of operation, etc. The committee will be making a recommendation to BGAC in the coming months. BGAC is paid up for web-hosting on the current site through October. Brenda is working to remove an earlier BGAC website because the two conflicting sites and domain names are causing confusion.

*Treasury Report* The Finance Committee (Kelsey, Brenda, Nancy, Jacqui) will meet on Friday morning (May 8<sup>th</sup>) at Grounds for Thought from 11-12 to finalize the forms for the IRS, which are due shortly. Following that meeting, the committee will meet periodically to formalize other recommendations regarding budgetary priorities.

*Art Walk*- The event was a success, but a few matters do need to be worked out at the follow-up meeting with Downtown BG. Besides Beth and Brenda, Alice, Jacqui, and Kelsey will be included in that meeting, which will occur later in the month, after May 20<sup>th</sup>.

- IV. Old Business- Jacqui e-mailed a copy of a useful, detailed template for the planning and management of events to all BGAC members . The group will examine the template and use it to plan upcoming events.
- IV. New Business- The group will discuss the possibility of joining the BG Chamber of Commerce in a future meeting.
